 - REL Pacific will assist with Data Governance Work
 - Dr. Tydeman who was the Data Governance Chair of Hawaii's educational system will lead the discussion today
 - Use CEDS data definition. Adapt it to CMI.
 - Dr. Tydeman confirmed that the CEDS regional group will provide support to CMI in its next grant cycle starting in May
 - In the development of CMI's data definition, it is necessary to also develop a data crosswalk.
 - Since CMI's data systems are not integrated, data alignment will address data mismatch and data errors. This will ensure data integrity across systems.
 - CMI will need to identify the one source of information for each data element. Changes to this source should force changes to the other systems that use the information.
 - CMI to plan for ABE and Maritime programs data and how it should be integrated into existing data systems.
 - If students are self-reporting to two different systems (e.g. SIS and FAFSA), one system will often have more accurate information. Some colleges use the FAFSA form as the application form.
 - 1. Sali will look at other colleges' approach to using the FAFSA form as the college's application form.
 - 2. Dr. Tydeman will provide examples on how colleges reconcile the FAFSA form with the application form
