## Credit level students who successfully navigate 5 courses per semester graduate with ASEE in 2 years.

All courses below are required. **C** or better is required in each course.

Students may be admitted at credit level OR achieve credit level by satisfactorily completing ENG 90's & Math 099.

The first credit semester MUST include ENG 111 – gateway to all Education courses.

The 4-credit SCI course and 4-credit EDU 251 Science for Teachers may NOT be taken in the same semester. Both classes have a lab and earn 4 credits. It is impossible to schedule both during the same semester as well as a very bad idea for the student.

Both EDU 150 and EDU 250 as well as PSY 101 and PSY 201 are sequential. EDU 150 is a prerequisite to EDU 250; PSI 101 is a prerequisite to PSY 201. It is important that the first course in the sequence be completed successfully early in the students' program to ensure time to complete both courses successfully within the 4 semesters.
